Step 1 - How to Practice- Download Practice App and Login

1. Download the App

- If you are assigned Challenger Category (Age 6- 8 Years)
 - Click on the Challenger Button
 - You will see Ten Practice Rounds from Round 1 to Round 10.

- In this Round every participant will get a 120 hours (5 days) window to give their 3 attempts at their convenience.
- Every Category of Participants will have 3 attempts each of unlimited MCQ Format Questions to be solved.
 - Challenger Category 3 attempts of 6 Minutes Each
 - Master Category 3 attempts of 7 Minutes Each
 - Grandmaster Category 3 attempts of 8 Minutes Each
- The total score of these 3 attempts will be considered for ranking the participants in each category

Scoring

Scoring will be + 10 for every Right Answer and - 2 for Incorrect answer.

ROUND 2, THE GRAND FINALE, will be an ON-CAMERA LIVE EVENT on Zoom.

Details will be shared with the Finalists after the Round 1 Results are Declared.

- In these round participants will get 100 MCQ format questions that they have to answer in the given time allocated as per their age category
